

West Rocks Middle School Student Dress Code (Created by the Faculty November 2018)

School attire should be appropriate. Dress with pride in yourself and your school community! All staff members have the right to correct and monitor.

(Guiding question: Would I wear these jeans to a job interview?)

The following clothing styles are not permitted:

- Slides, flip flops, high heels, no open back shoes (safety)
- See-through, mesh tops, low-cut shirts
- Midriff crop tops and spaghetti straps
- Under garments should not be visible
- Accessories: bags, purses, sunglasses, hats, bandanas, hoods
- Inappropriate or offensive language or graphics
- Winter coats
- Very short-shorts and skirts (need to be long enough to extend below the fingertips of the wearer)
- *Inappropriate clothing that is distracting or determined detrimental to the overall school environment*

Staff should direct a student to change if the dress code is violated. Physical Education teachers have extra clothing.

If students refuse, staff members will contact the office to report the violation and refusal.
